### **INNOVATIONS IN TECHNOLOGY IMPLEMENTATION IN TEACHING**

#### Order Verification Objective Structured Clinical Evaluation (OSCE)

- Created the format for 1) utilizing order verification to teach the most prescribed drugs and 2) an OSCE format that tests students' ability to appropriately check prescription orders.
- Developed a catalogue of 100 verification scenarios that are selected during the OSCEs.
